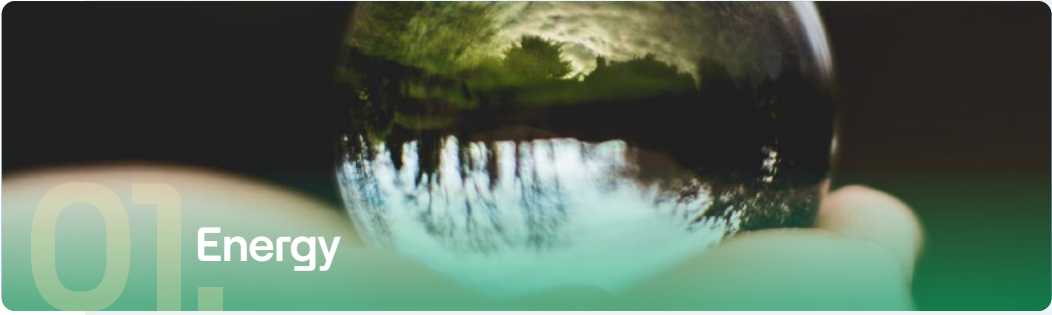

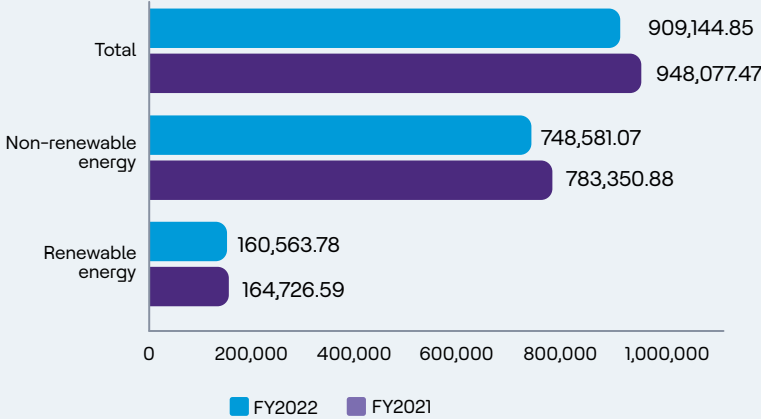

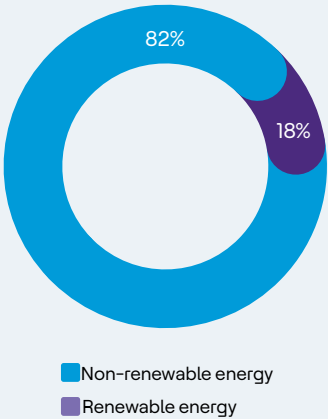

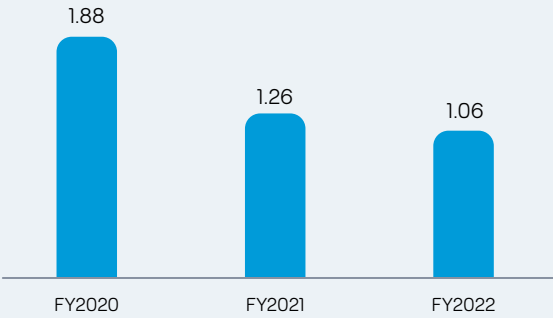
**Energy Consumption (GJ)**



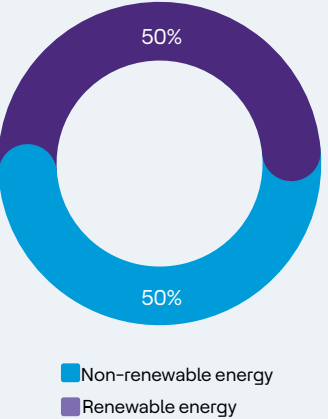
**Global Energy Mix FY2022**



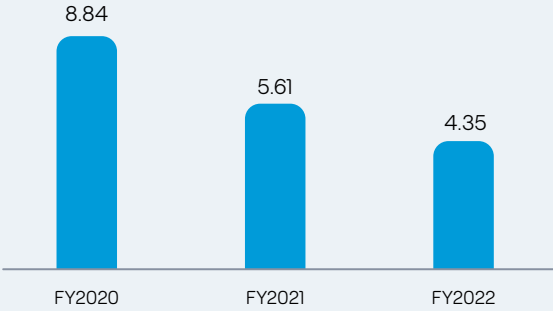
**Energy Intensity (GJ/Million INR)**



**Energy mix at Major Data Centres (FY2022)**



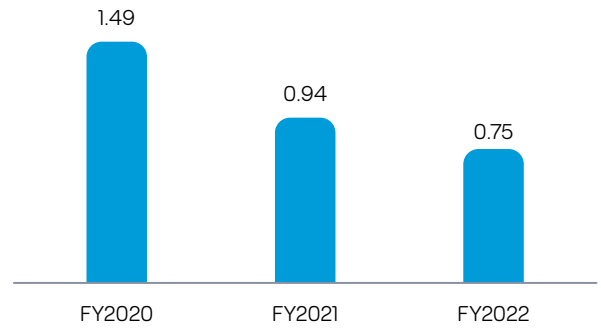
**Energy Intensity (GJ/Employee)**



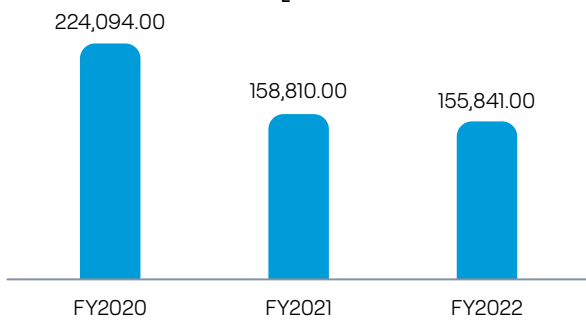

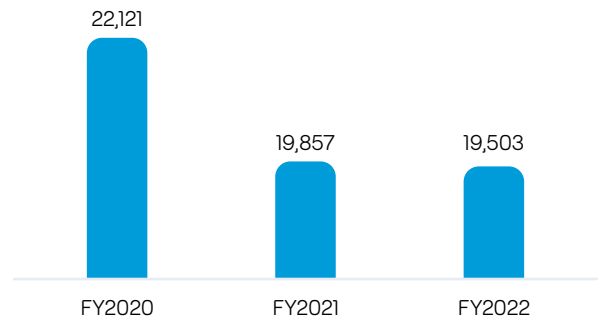
Emission Intensity (mtCO<sub>2</sub>e/Employee)



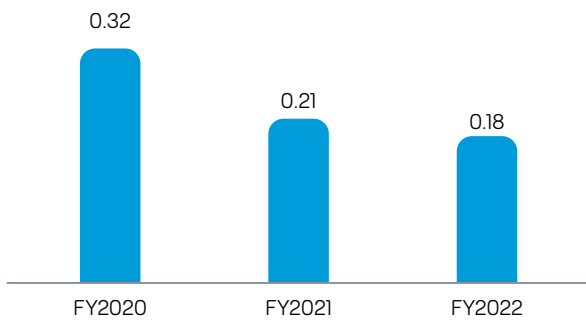
Scope 1 & 2 emissions (mtCO<sub>2</sub>e)



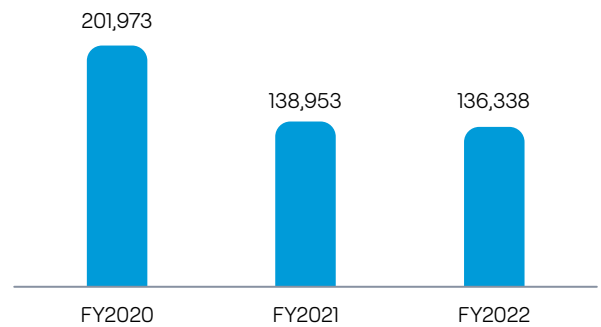
Scope 1 emission (mt CO<sub>2</sub>e)



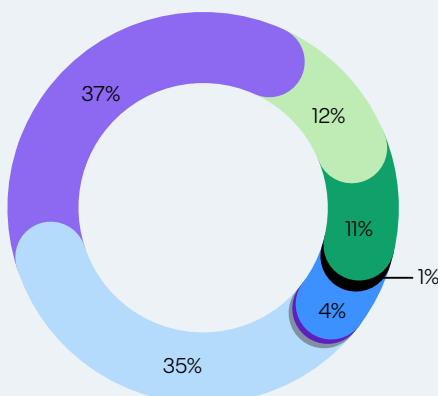
Emission Intensity (mtCO<sub>2</sub>e/Million INR)



Scope 2 emission (mt CO<sub>2</sub>e)

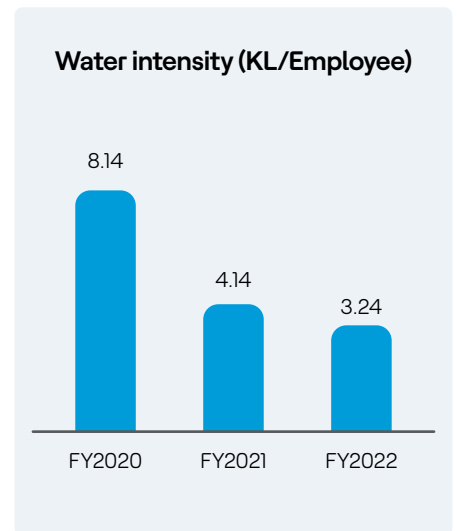
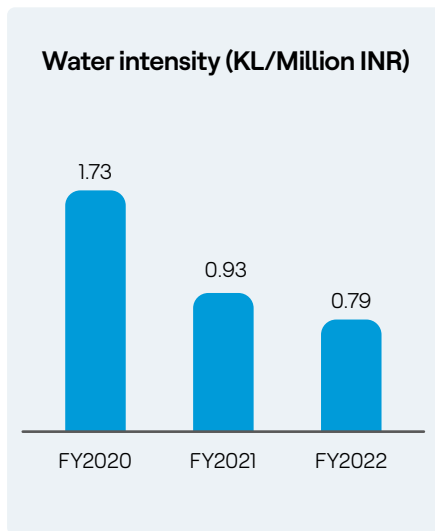
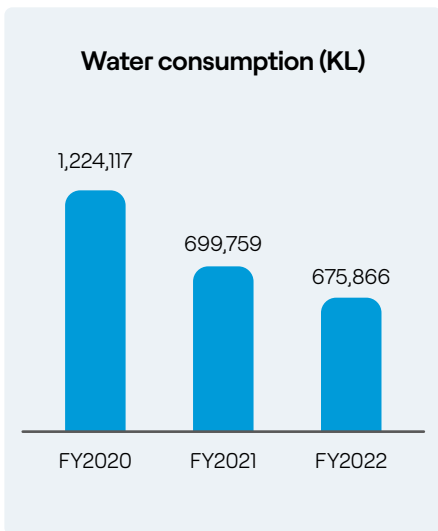


Scope 3 emissions (FY2022)

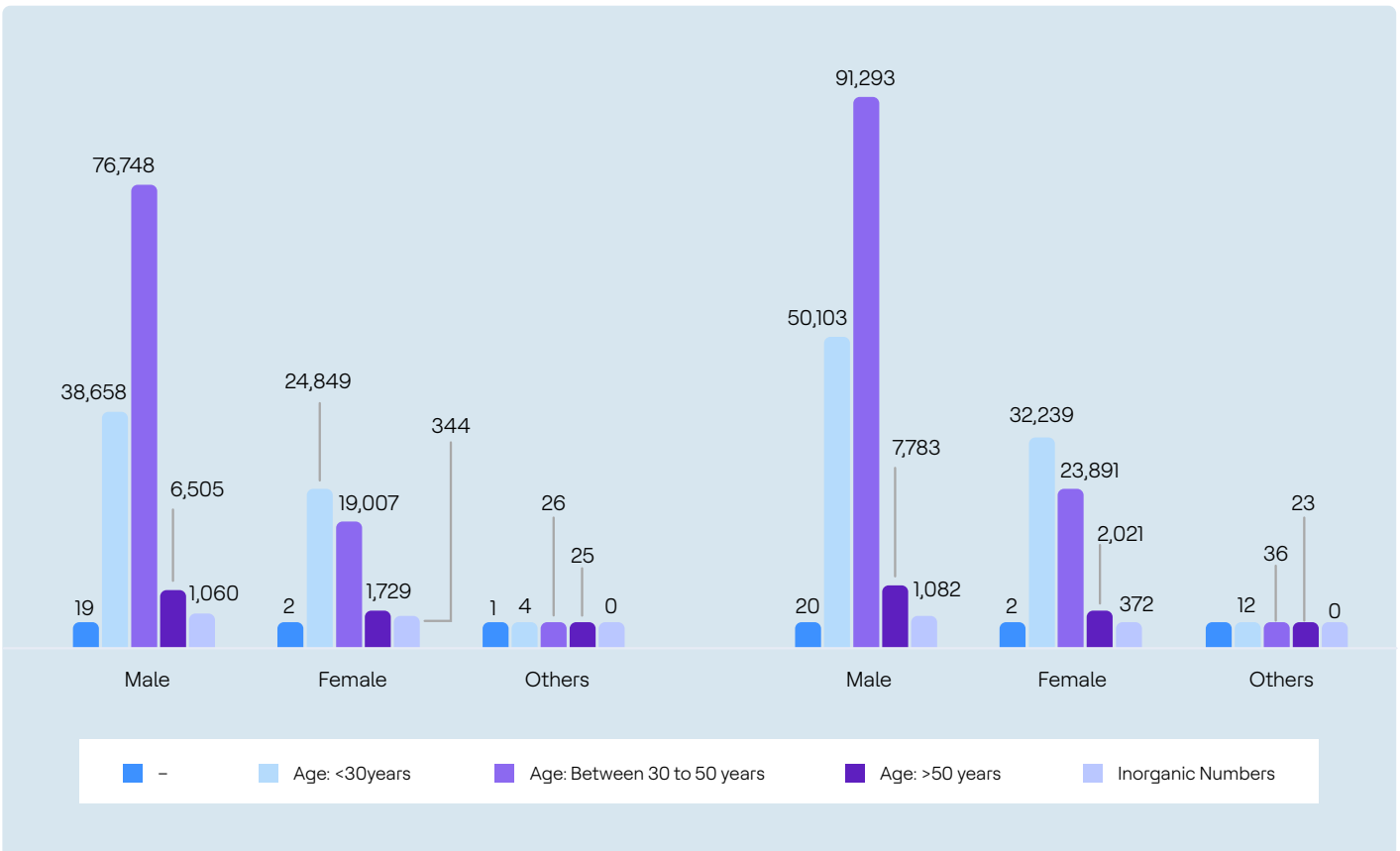


While more than 99% of our female employees who took maternity leave returned to work, the retention rate for these employees for one year and beyond was at 77.2% during FY2022.



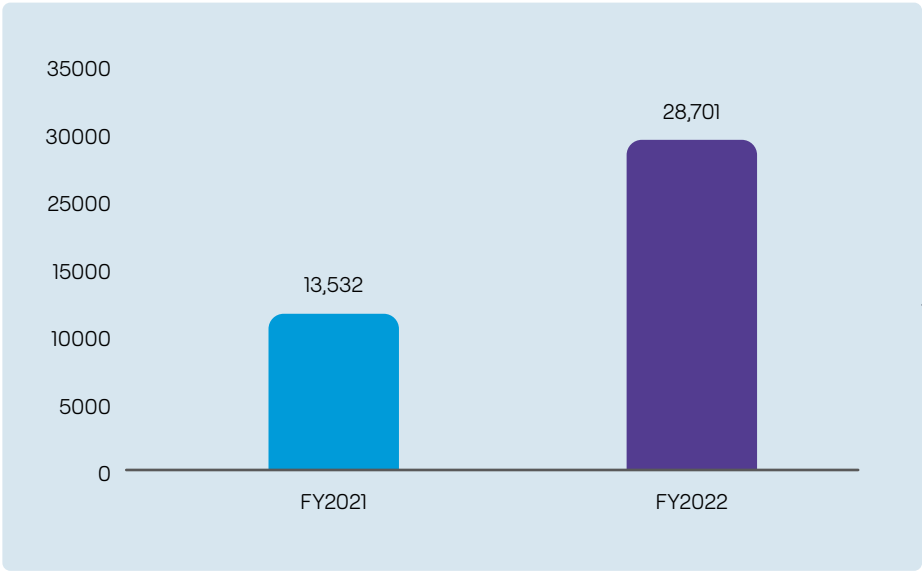

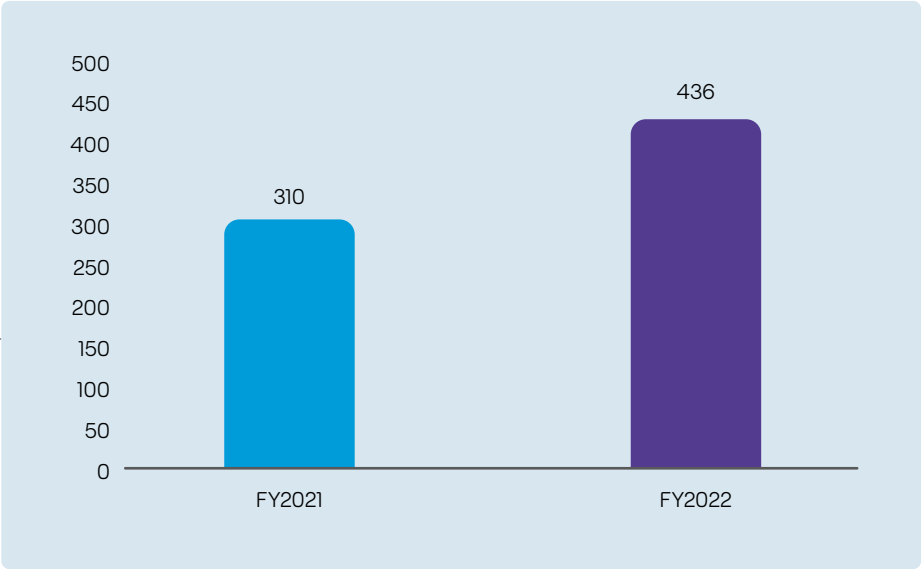

No. of women hired

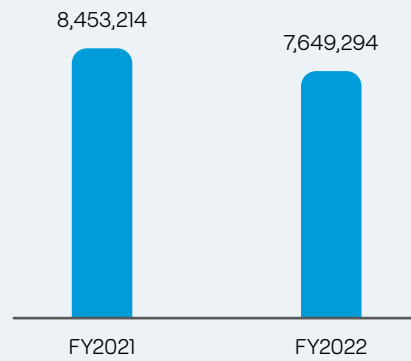


Employees with disabilities

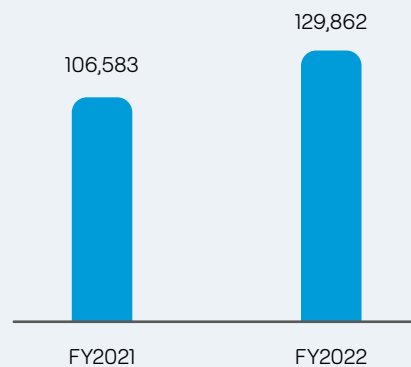

### Total Training Hours (hours)

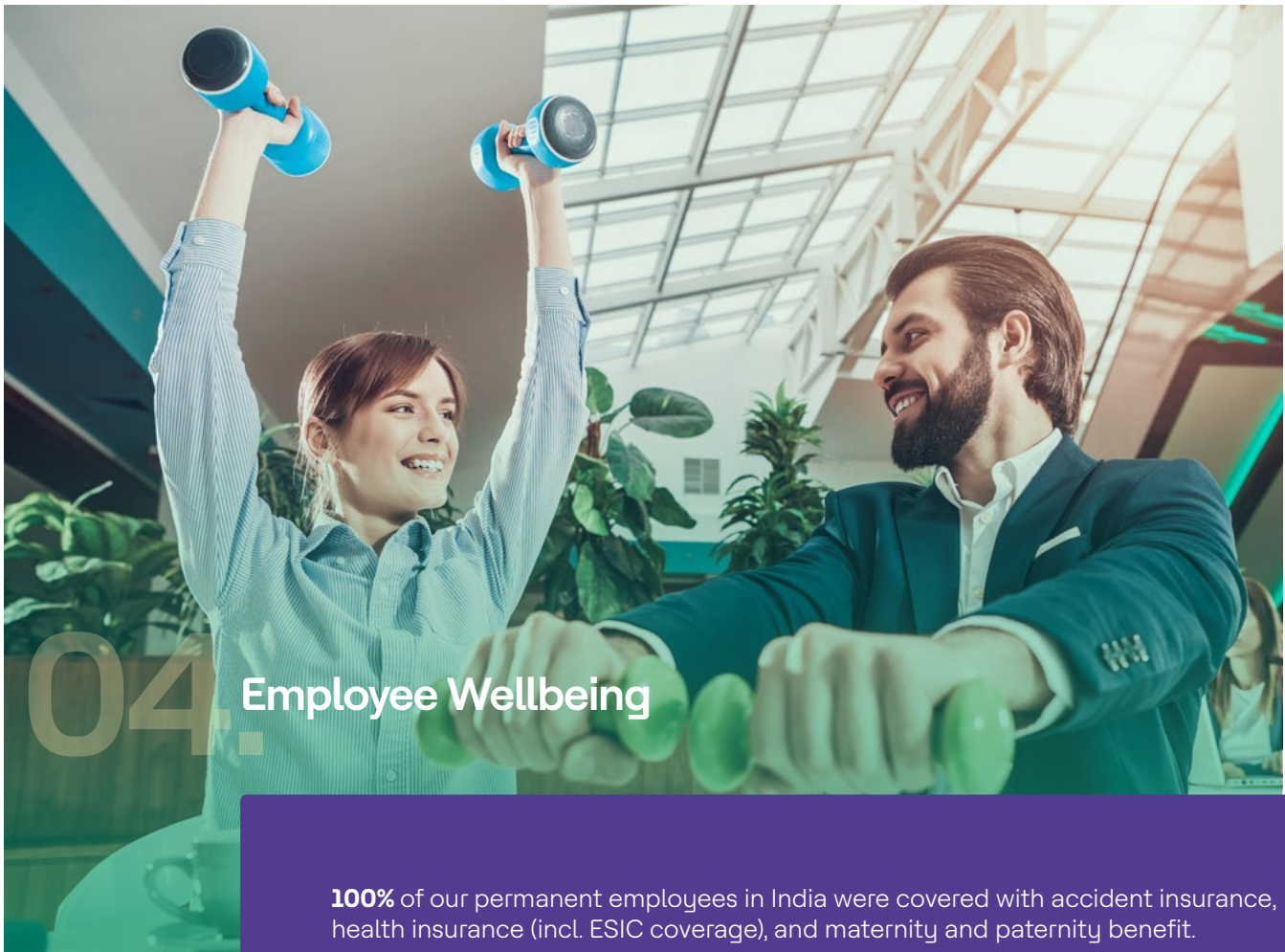


### Skills improvement (number of employees)

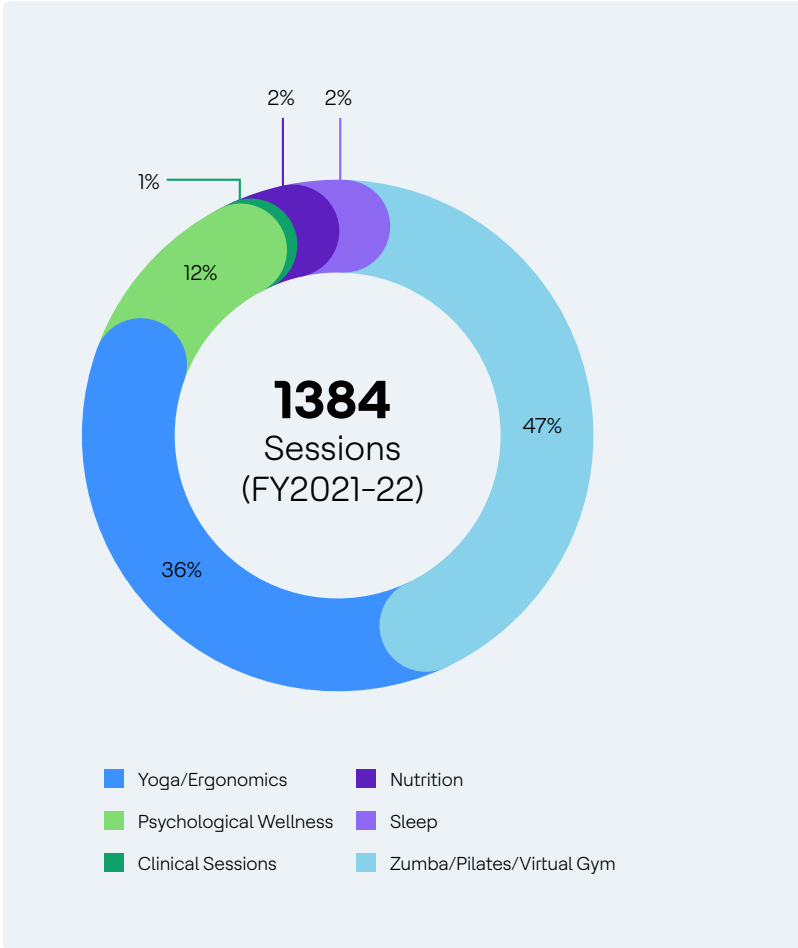

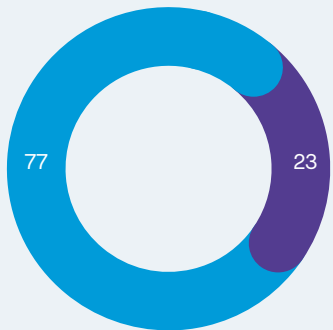

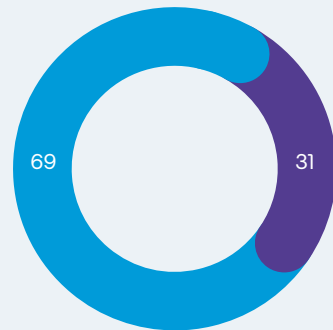
